General

This Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between the Owner of the Dog (“Client”) and The Pawsitive K9 Coach, LLC (“Trainer”) for the sole purpose of hiring Trainer to perform the services identified below (*please check*):

Program

The effectiveness of any lesson/program depends on many variables: the Client’s participation, health of the dog and continued practice. Client understands the success of the training relies on Client’s learning how to reinforce the proper behaviors, maintaining the behaviors that have been taught and following through with in-home lessons. In-home lessons must take place weekly to maintain consistency of program. During Lessons or any Board and Train Kamp, I authorize Trainer to take my dog into public spaces for the purpose of training my dog.

Vaccination Policy

To prevent the spread of disease while Client’s dog is at Trainer’s facility, dogs must be current on flea prevention and vaccines: Rabies (if old enough), Distemper Parvo, Bordetella and have a negative Fecal. It is Client’s responsibility to provide proof of vaccination history. Client further understands that even if a dog is vaccinated against kennel cough or other illnesses it is possible that a dog may contract kennel cough or another illness during its stay.

Medical Treatment Policy

Client understands, agrees and authorizes, at Client’s expense, that if; in Trainer’s opinion Client’s dog is in need of medical attention, that medical or emergency services will be obtained. Every effort will be made to contact Client and/or the emergency contact listed on the Client Information Form prior to obtaining medical treatment. If Client or the emergency contact cannot be reached, Trainer will contact Client’s veterinarian and Trainer will proceed per the veterinarian’s instructions. Client agrees to assume all costs for any charges related to emergency care, including office visits, procedures, medications, surgeries, etc.

Payment for Services / Cancellation Policy

In-Home Lessons: All in-home lessons must be paid in full at the time of the lesson. All lesson packages must be used within 6 months of the first lesson. Lessons not used within 6 months will be forfeited. It is Client's responsibility to schedule lessons. Scheduled lessons can be changed 24 hours prior. A lesson not cancelled or a no-show will be forfeited.

Board and Train Kamps/Boarding Services: All Board and Train Kamps/Boarding Services require half of the payment when the dog begins training/boarding and the balance is due when the dog returns home.

Hurricane Policy

Trainer has a strict policy for all dogs in our training kamps or boarding at our facility during Hurricane Season (normally June 1 – December 1). Neither people nor pets are safe during a hurricane. Even though a hurricane may pass quickly, Trainer could be without power and potable water for a long period of time. Trainer will not house dogs in that type of environment. To ensure the safety of Client's dog, Trainer requires that all dogs be picked up from its facility by Client no less than 48 hours prior to landfall. We cannot overstate the importance of this. Clients must provide Trainer with the name and phone number of two local contacts who are willing to pick up Client's dog in the event Trainer's facility must be evacuated and Client is unable to retrieve Client's dog. In the event the alternate contacts provided are not reachable or cannot pick up Client's dog, Client authorizes Trainer to transport/ board Client's dog at an alternate boarding facility if possible. Your initials indicate that this Hurricane Policy is in addition to all other policies and procedures of Trainer and any additional expenses incurred by Trainer due to this Hurricane Policy including, but not limited to, transportation fees, gas, food, bottled water, medical, etc. will be at Client's expense.

Liability Waiver

Trainer will endeavor to create as safe an environment as possible for the training of Client's dog and will offer only sound, safe, and responsible training and training instructions. However, to the extent that Trainer is insured for any unintentional or negligent errors, omissions, or incorrect assertions, Trainer will be responsible for any such acts or omissions, but only to the extent of such insurance. Client has been told by Trainer and understands the inherent risks of owning a dog, including but not limited to the risk of dog bites. Client represents and warrants that Client has provided Trainer with full, complete, accurate information regarding any bite history and similar incidents or hazardous tendencies of Client's dog, and that Client will update that information if it changes. Client understands that Client will remain responsible for the actions of Client's dog at all times, and agrees to indemnify, release, and hold harmless Trainer of any and all claims, whether made by Client or any third party, of injury, expense, costs, or damages caused by Client's dog. Client understands that the recommendation of any other product or service is not a guarantee of satisfaction with that product or service. This contract, together with language expressly incorporated into it in writing, is the full and complete agreement between Client and Trainer. A complete and accurate copy of this contract is as valid as the original. This contract is made valid by in-person signatures, electronically signed signatures, or upon receipt of a signed, scanned copy by email.
